11. Reduce our carbon footprint in line with the objectives of the Principality and the SBM Group.
12. Fully implement our responsible purchasing policy.

13. Prioritize organic and local purchases, short supply chains, and seasonal products
→ Partnership with Domaine d'Agerbol at RCM
14. Promote clean mobility by offering electric vehicle transfers to our guests
→ E-bike station
15. Encourage staff to use eco-friendly modes of transport

ENHANCEMENT AND PRESERVATION OF RESOURCES AND HERITAGE

17. Reduce waste at the source across all streams, in line with Monaco's 2030 environmental program
18. Control the use of hazardous products and recycle contaminated product containers through a dedicated channel
19. Recover and repurpose waste across 22 categories: cooking oils, Category 3 animal by-products (SPA3), metals, cigarette butts, etc.
→ Upcoming collection initiative: coffee grounds for the vegetable garden
20. Promote local farming and traditional crops
→ "Menton Pink Onion" in partnership with the *Semences Paysannes* (Peasant Seeds) association
21. Maintain the ban on consuming endangered species
→ Participation in the MisterGoodFish or Ethic Ocean programs
22. Support local organizations in protecting endangered species, in partnership with the LPO (League for the Protection of Birds)
23. Awareness-raising days for staff and young people
24. Support and implement projects with a positive impact on biodiversity, such as the underwater reef breakwater
→ Organizing snorkeling discovery outings
25. Conserve water resources through awareness campaigns and recovery initiatives
→ "Make every drop count"
